- Data is subject to revision as additional information about known accidents/claims is received, and as new accident/claim reports are received and processed.

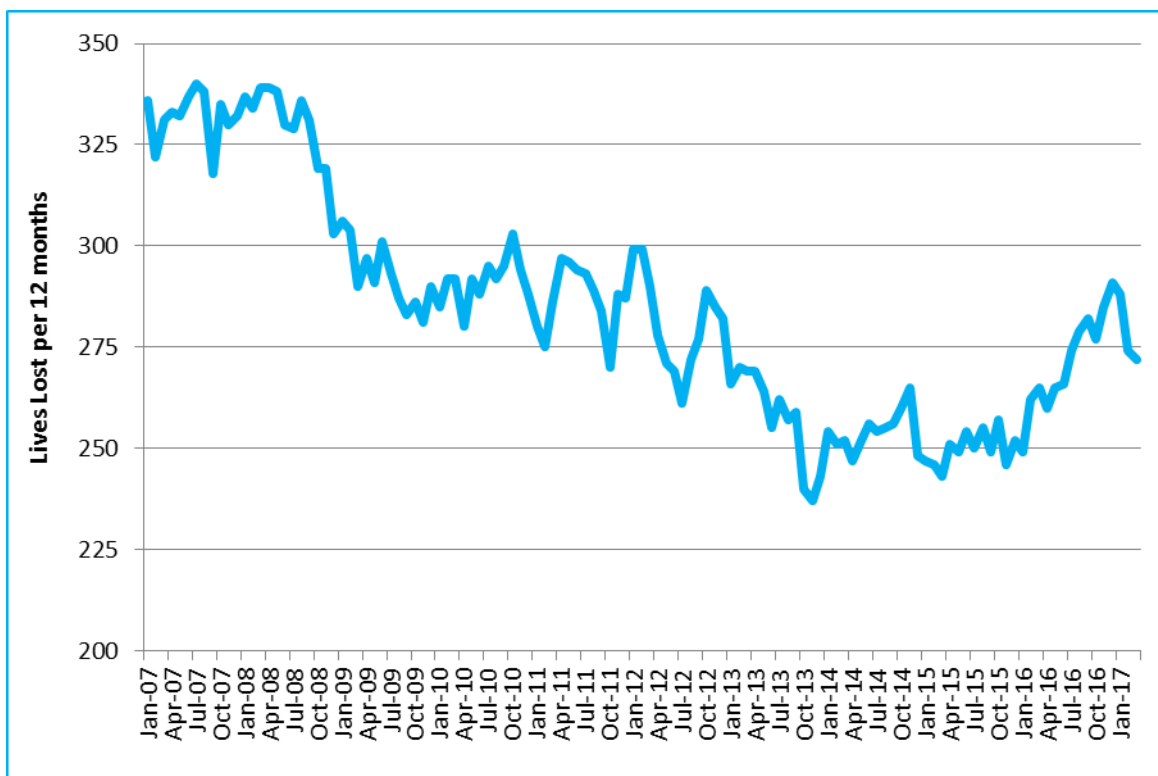
## Status Report

### Lives lost on Victorian roads

- The rolling 12 month number of lives lost to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017 stands at 272. The rolling 12 month number of lives lost to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016 stood at 265 (an increase of 7).
- In January, 18 people’s lives were lost in 2017 compared to 21 in January 2016 (a decrease of 3).
- In February, 19 people lost their lives in 2017 compared to 33 in February 2016 (a decrease of 14).
- There were 23 people’s lives lost in March 2017 on Victorian roads. This compares to 25 in March 2016.

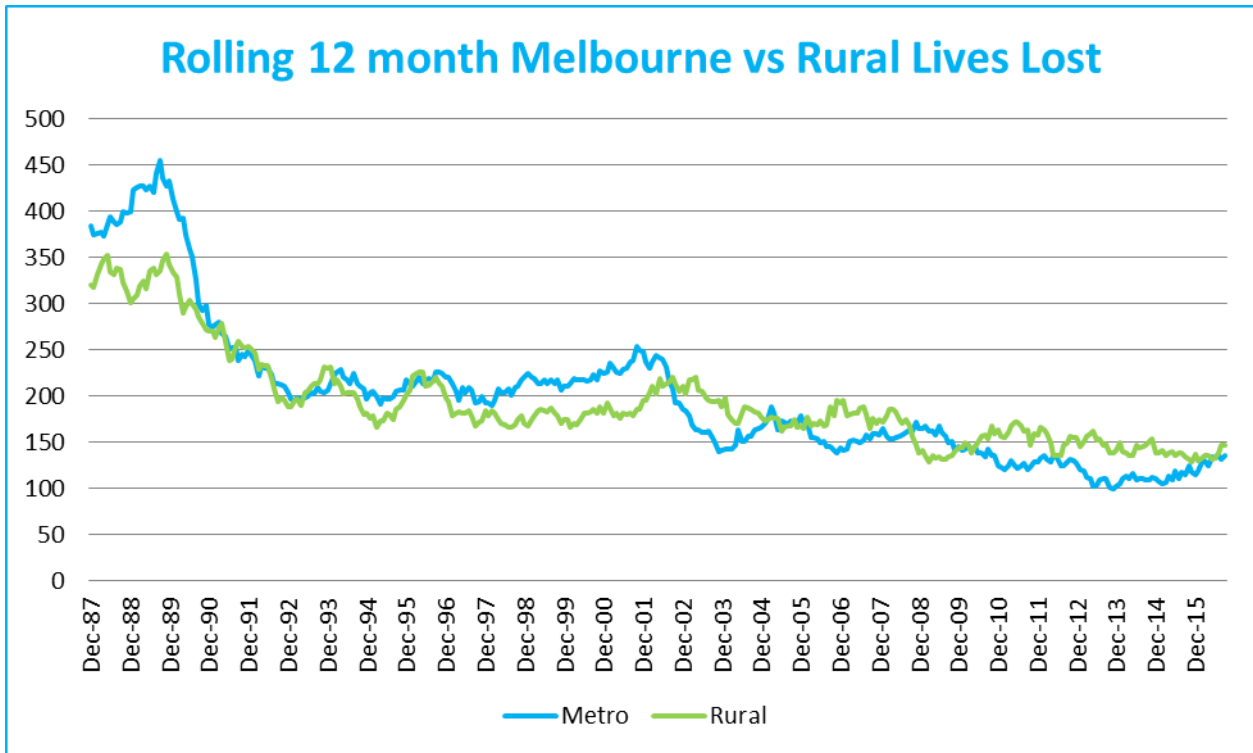

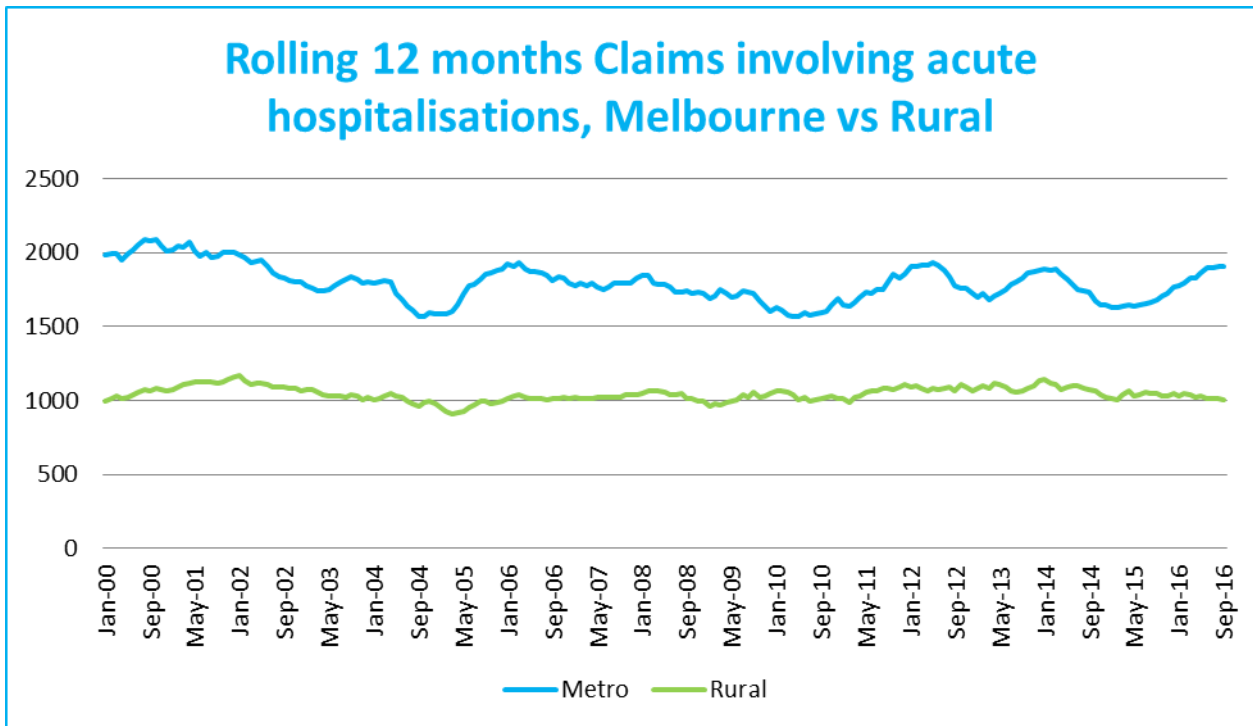

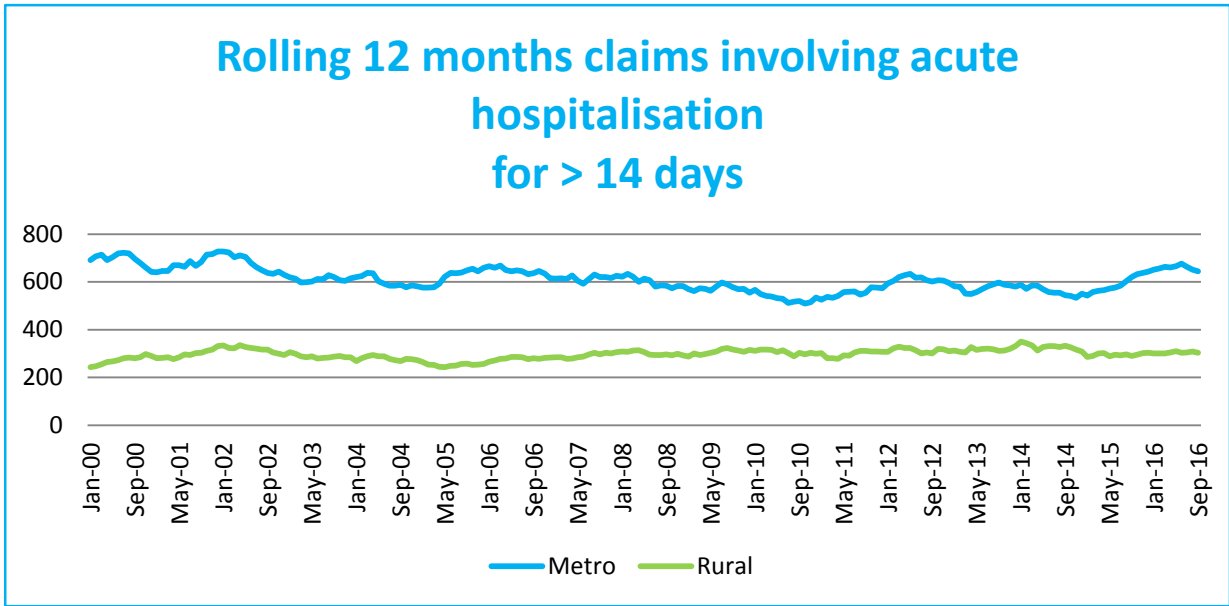
