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Notes about the data in this report


- All data provided in this report is the data most recently available at time of production. Fatality data are updated to the end of report month. A 6-month lag applies to TAC claims data.

Status Report

Lives lost on Victorian roads

- In a 12-month period from 1st January 2020 to the end of December 2020, 211 people lost their lives compared to 266 people lost their lives during the previous 12-month period from January 2019 to December 2019. This represents 55 less lives lost.











Victoria – Lives Lost, rolling 12 months total




Graph 1a – Melbourne/Rural lives lost
