

Safe Local Roads and Streets Program Reference Group

Membership nomination

Through the Safe Local Roads and Streets Program, the Department of Transport and Planning and the Transport Accident Commission will work alongside all Victorian local governments to deliver \$200 million of safety improvements on the highest risk local roads, intersections and precincts, such as schools.

Recognising the barriers local governments face in delivering road safety improvements, this program will also support local governments to build capacity and capability to deliver safer local roads into the future.

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To support this program, we're establishing the Safe Local Roads and Streets Program Reference Group. This group will support the development of the frameworks, investment guides, tools and resources that will support local governments to plan, fund and deliver road safety improvements throughout this program and into the future.

Reference Group structure

The Safe Local Roads and Streets Program Reference Group will include representatives from local government and relevant peak bodies.

The group will commence in May 2023 and will provide an important voice to local government needs throughout the program's three-year duration.

It is expected the group will meet quarterly or as required, with meetings lasting around two – three hours.

Positions in the group will be non-remunerative.
